General Overview

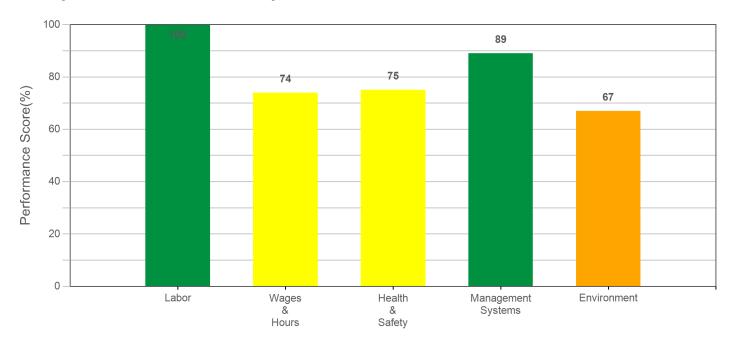

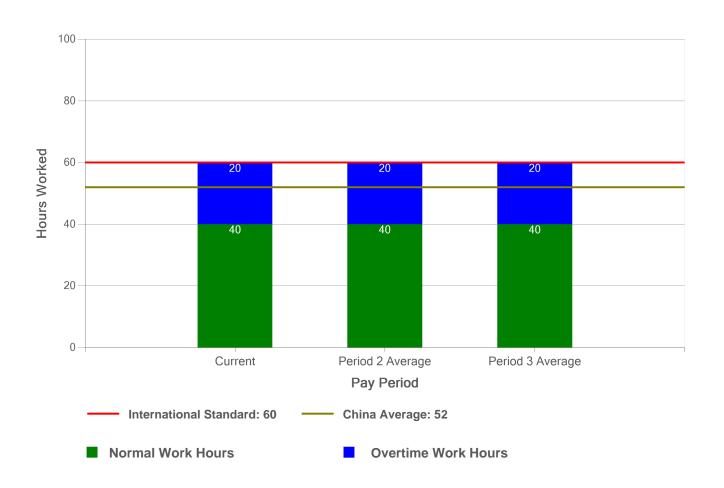

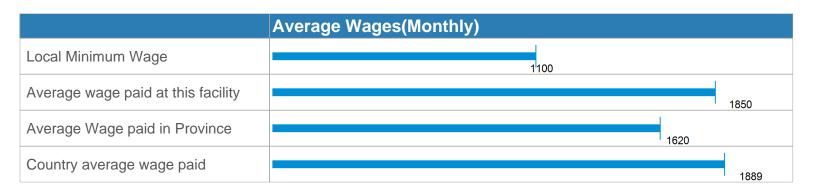
Average Total Hours Worked - Weekly



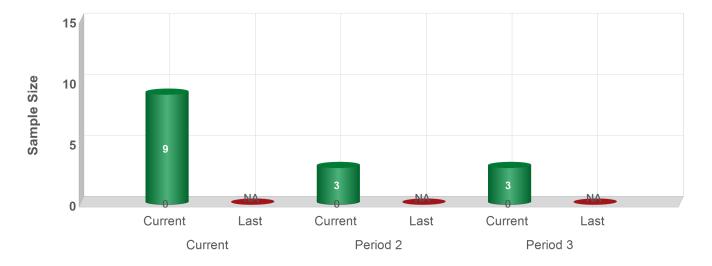
